**I. Call to Order, Roll Call** – The meeting was called to order at 2:07 p.m. A quorum was present.

**II. Community Participation** – There was no community participation.

**III. Review and Vote on Approval of SSA #16 Minutes from January 20, 2026** – There was a motion by CV and seconded by TP to accept the January 20, 2026 meeting minutes as written. The motion passed unanimously.

## **IV. New Business**

- A. ENOSIS: Greek Independence Parade Proposal – George Reveliotis, (GR) the President of ENOSIS attended the meeting via Zoom. The parade will be on Sunday, April 18, 2026. GR reported that a regiment of Evzones will be present this year and will be present each year in the future for the Greek Independence Parade. There was a motion made by MT and seconded by EM to grant \$25,000 to ENOSIS to support the community efforts in this matter. The motion passed unanimously.
- B. Power Washing Proposal – TA presented the Spring Power Washing Proposal. This should be done before the Parade. There was a motion made by CV and seconded by TP to pay \$6,700.00 for a Spring Power Wash only. The motion passed unanimously.
- C. Audit Proposal – PD explained the status of the internal Bookkeeper and Auditor situation. The Financial Statements are due in April 2026 and will be addressed at that meeting. There was a motion made by EM and seconded by CV to hire Cary Hall CPA as independent contractor to handle the audit for the SSA. The motion passed unanimously.
- D. Chicago Does Interactive Video Map Proposal from Ateema – The SSA discussed the Video Map and the Crowne Plaza Interactive on a digital basis. There was a motion by EM and seconded by TP to defer this matter to the next meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
